This bid includes 3 sites: Parker Park, Under the Palms Park and the 7th Street Restroom. The work includes minor site grading, a gravel parking lot, landscaping, fencing, utilities and rest room buildings.

**BIDDERS ARE REQUIRED TO BID ALL 3 SITES. THE PROJECT WILL BE AWARDED UNDER 1 CONTRACT**
