



To better serve you, the Utility Department will be smoke testing all city sewer lines. The smoke testing will occur sometime during **January 23rd through April 24th** between the hours of **8 am** until **4 pm**. Please see the tentative schedule below. This schedule is subject to change and will be updated as needed due to any unforeseen delays or weather issues. On the inside of your house, smoke or its odor may come out of the plumbing or fixtures. The smoke being used is harmless to humans, plants and animals and leaves no residuals or stains. If smoke gets into your house, please ventilate your house.

The smoke is an indication that an issue with the sewer line in your home may be allowing gases and odors from the sewer into your house/building, which can be an unpleasant and a dangerous health hazard. Location, identification, and correction of the source of smoke entering your house/building is urgently advised. The correction of any defects in the pipes and sewer on private property is the responsibility of the owner. If you have any questions, please contact:
