

ORDINANCE NO. 109

AN ORDINANCE ASSESSING COURT COST FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT EDUCATIONAL EXPENDITURES; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH AND RECITING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TOWN OF MEXICO BEACH, BAY COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. There is hereby assessed an additional Court Cost of \$2.00 against any person, firm, corporation or organization for violation of municipal ordinances, excepting motor vehicle parking violations, for law enforcement educational expenditures of Police Officers of the Town of Mexico Beach.

Section 2. There is hereby assessed a court cost of \$2.00 from every bond estreated or forfeited bail bond for the violation of municipal ordinance excepting motor vehicle parking violations, for law enforcement educational expenditures for the Police Officers for the Town of Mexico Beach.

Section 3. The assessment of court costs as provided in Sections One (1) and Two (2) is in addition to the mandatory assessment of a like sum provided by Section 943.25(4), Florida Statutes.


Section 4. All ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication as required by law.


