

ORDINANCE NO. 123

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 10, NOTE NUMBER 3,  
ORDINANCE NO. 106, PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN  
OF MEXICO BEACH:

Section 1. That Section 10, note number 3, Ordinance No. 106,  
shall be amended to read as follows:


3. Additional service to be determined by user survey at company  
expense.

The company (CABLEVISION OF MEXICO BEACH) reserves the right to  
set rates as it deems appropriate and reasonable, however, increases in the  
basic service rate shall not exceed the rates which would result from the  
application of the cost of living increase that has accrued from the date  
of enactment of this ordinance to any date the rates are reset to the initial  
rates specified above, unless approved by the Town of Mexico Beach. For  
such computation the national consumer price index shall be used to represent  
changes in cost of living. The initial basic service rates as established  
herein shall remain in effect during the company's first year of operation  
and at no time will the basic service rates be changed by less than fifty  
(\$0.50) cents per month.


Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
