AN ORDINANCE LEVYING AN OCCUPATIONAL LICENSE TAX ON PERSONS, FIRMS AND CORPORATIONS CARRYING ON OR ENGAGING IN BUSINESS, PROFESSIONS, OR OCCUPATIONS WITHIN THE CITY OF MEXICO BEACH OR MAINTAINING BUSINESS LOCATIONS OR BRANCH OFFICES WITHIN THE CITY OF MEXICO BEACH; PROVIDING CLASSIFICATIONS OF SUCH BUSINESSES, OCCUPA-TIONS AND PROFESSIONS AND THE AMOUNT OF TAX FOR EACH CLASSIFICATION; PROVIDING FOR THE SALE OF LICENSES; PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES FOR DELINQUENT LICENSES AND OPERATING A BUSINESS WITHOUT A LICENSE; PROVIDING THAT PAYMENT OF LICENSE TAX NOT TO EXEMPT OTHER FORMS OF TAXATION; PROVIDING FOR TRANSFER OF LICENSES; REPEAL-ING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Mexico Beach, Florida, has determined that it is in the best interests of the people of the City of Mexico Beach that an Occupational License Tax be levied pursuant to Chapter 205, Florida Statutes, now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF MEXICO BEACH, FLORIDA:

Section 1. A license tax is hereby levied upon and shall be collected from every person exercising the privileges of carrying on or engaging in the business, professions, or occupations hereinafter specifically enumerated in the amounts as fixed hereinafter; each such amounts, unless otherwise specifically stated, being the amount payable as a license tax for exercising such privileges of carrying on or engaging in such business, profession or occupation mentioned for each, and it shall be unlawful for any person to carry on or engage in any business, occupation or profession herein prescribed and designated without having first paid the license tax as provided herein or complied with the terms hereof.

<u>Section 2</u>. All licenses shall be made out and issued by the Mexico Beach City Clerk upon payment of the fee set out in this ordinance, and to which shall be affixed the Seal of the City. At the discretion of the City Clerk and/or Mayor the license applicant may be required to appear before the City Council to seek approval prior to issuance of an Occupational License. Section 3. No person, firm, or corporation shall maintain a business location or branch office within the City of Mexico Beach for engaging in or managing any business, profession, or occupation within the City of Mexico Beach, or carry on or engage in any business, profession or occupation within the City of Mexico Beach unless a license shall have been procured from the City Clerk.

## Section 4. Duties and Responsibilities.

(a) It shall be the duty of all officers and agents of all corporations to see that all corporations comply with the provisions of this article; and all officers or agents of any corporation required by this article to be licensed, which shall carry on or conduct any business without having made the payment and otherwise complied with the terms of this article, shall be subject to the same penalty or penalties imposed upon persons violating the provisions of this article.

(b) It shall be the duty of any individual agent, rental agent, manager, or chief officer of any company, chief executive officer or resident agent of any corporation managing the operations of any business, any rentals, any sales or other businesses or occupations for another individual(s), owner(s) or stockholder(s) to acquire the appropriate license(s).

(c) The members of any firm who fail or refuse to comply with the provision of this article shall likewise be subject to the same penalty or penalties imposed upon persons violating the provisions hereof.

(d) In the absence of any owner, proprietor, manager or agent, any person operating or in charge of any business being conducted without the requirements of this article having been complied with, shall be subject to the same penalty or penalties imposed upon persons violating provisions of this article.

Section 5. When any occupation, business, or profession shall fall into more than one of the classifications contained in this Ordinance such occupation, business, or profession shall not be required to obtain a separate license provided classifications are part of commonly accepted services or business operations. Any dispute will be referred to the City Council.

Section 6. All business licenses may be transferred to a new owner when there is a bona fide sale of the business and upon payment of a transfer fee of \$3.00 and presentation to the City Clerk of evidence of the sale of the original license.

Section 7. Any license may be transferred from one location to another location within the City upon payment of a transfer fee of \$3.00 accompanied by a written request and presentation of the original license to the City Clerk.

Section 8. EXEMPTIONS--The City Council may, upon application, waive any license required by this chapter where the applicant for such license is a non-profit, charitable or religious organization which has its principal place of business in the City of Mexico Beach, Florida. Any disabled veteran shall be exempt from the application of the provisions of this Ordinance, upon presentation to the City Clerk of his state and/or county exemption certificate. This exemption is limited to one business or occupation.

Section 9. All licenses shall be sold beginning September 1 of each year and shall be due and payable on October 1 of each year and shall expire on September 30 of the succeeding year. Licenses issued after April 1, to expire on September 30, shall be issued upon payment of one-half the annual fee. No other fractional year licenses shall be issued.

Section 10. Those licenses not renewed by October 1 shall be considered delinquent and subject to a delinquency penalty of ten (10) per cent of the license fee for the month of October, plus an additional five (5) per cent penalty of the license fee for each month of delinquency thereafter until paid. After being more than three (3) months delinquent, shall be punished as provided by Section 13 and Section 14 of this ordinance

Section 11. Every person holding a license issued hereunder shall exhibit the same when called upon to do so by any authorized officer of the City, and all such licenses shall be conspicuously displayed at all times.

Section 12. Any person engaging in or managing any business, occupation, or profession without first obtaining the occupational license required hereunder, shall be subject to a penalty of twenty-five (25) per cent of the license determined to be due, in addition to any other penalty provided by law or ordinance.

Section 13. Any person who shall fail to secure a license as provided hereunder and to pay, at the time of application therefor, all fees, charges and taxes incident thereto, may be punished by a fine not exceeding Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars, and each day of continuing violation shall constitute a separate offense.

Section 14. The payment of license taxes levied by this Ordinance may be enforced by any legal procedures authorized by law. Any person failing to adhere to the provisions contained herein shall be liable for all attorney fees and costs for enforcement.

<u>Section 15</u>. Any person required by the provisions of this Ordinance to furnish information who shall furnish false information shall be punished as provided in Section 13 of this Ordinance.

<u>Section 18</u>. Should any section or part herein be declared invalid for any reason it shall not effect the enforceability or validity of any other section or part of this Ordinance.

Section 19. This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
