

ORDINANCE NO. 214

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE MANAGEMENT AND PRESERVATION OF ALL CITY OWNED PROPERTY, FOR THE PURPOSE OF INSURING CONTINUED ACCESS THERETO AND KEEPING IN PERPETUITY ALL LANDS USED FOR RECREATION AND OTHERS DEDICATED FOR DRAINAGE AND UTILITY PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City Council of Mexico Beach, Florida, is of the opinion that for immediate protection of all City-owned property does hereby enact this ordinance, therefore

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF MEXICO BEACH, FLORIDA:

Section 1. There is hereby established a procedure that any request for utilization of City property must be presented to the City Council of Mexico Beach for specific approval prior to the requestor utilizing such property for personal use.

Section 2. That each requestor will coordinate with the City Clerk to be placed on the agenda for the next scheduled meeting of the City Council to present the request for utilization of public lands, the purpose for which it will be used, and associated structure plans if in fact building will occur.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
