

ORDINANCE NO. 226

AN ORDINANCE REZONING A CERTAIN PARCEL OF LAND WITHIN
THE CITY OF MEXICO BEACH.

WHEREAS, the City of Mexico Beach has adopted a comprehensive
plan which zoned all lands within the limits of the city, and

WHEREAS, the Zoning Commission, after due public notice and public
hearing, forwarded the request to the City Council with a recommendation
for approval, and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it is to the best
interest of the citizens of the City of Mexico Beach to adopt such
rezoning:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF MEXICO BEACH, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The following parcel of land is hereby rezoned as
follows:

a. Property located on 15th Street described as:

24 6S 12W 2.68A -1.8- 133A Beg 827.7' W of SE Cor Sec
Th Cont W 217' N 568.4' E 226.32' alg S RW SR 386A S
511.8' to POB

From RESIDENTIAL GENERAL to COMMERCIAL

Section 2. The rezoned land is subject to all zoning and
other pertinent ordinances of the City of Mexico Beach.

Section 3. This ordinance shall become effective upon
passage.
