

## ORDINANCE NO. 23

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING THAT ALL UTILITY LINES IN ANY NEW SUBDIVISION IN THE TOWN OF MEXICO BEACH, FLORIDA, SHALL BE UNDERGROUND; PROVIDING EXCEPTIONS; PROVIDING THAT THE PASSAGE OF SAID ORDINANCE IS AN EMERGENCY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Mexico Beach has determined that it is necessary to the preservation of the scenic beauty and the future orderly growth of the Town of Mexico Beach that this ordinance providing that all utility lines to any new subdivision in the Town of Mexico Beach, Florida, shall take effect immediately, now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TOWN OF MEXICO BEACH:

Section 1. That after the effective date of this ordinance all utility lines of Mexico Beach be placed underground and that no overhead utility lines be run to any new subdivisions except as hereinafter set forth.

Section 2. Overhead utility lines to such new subdivisions may be run for good cause shown upon written application by the utility company to the Town Council and a determination by the Town Council that such good cause has been shown.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage.

INTRODUCED at a special meeting of the Town Council on the 9th day of December, 1971, and ADOPTED by the Town Council on the 9th day of December, 1971, as an emergency ordinance.
