

ORDINANCE NO. 239

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 97, PROVIDING THE CRITERIA FOR A BOARD OF ADJUSTMENTS AND APPEALS, AND PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT AND PROCEDURES OF SAME, DELETING CERTAIN PROVISIONS, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Mexico Beach, Florida, has determined that it is in the best interest of the people to revise and update certain provisions of the current zoning ordinance,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF MEXICO BEACH, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Paragraph K. of Section 1 of Ordinance No. 97 shall be amended to read as follows:

K. - Board of Adjustments - a Board comprised of five (5) members with two (2) alternates will be established to review and make recommendations to the City Council concerning any matter requiring a variance to existing zoning requirements. All appointees to the Board of Adjustments must be residents and registered voters of the City of Mexico Beach, Bay County, Florida, at the time of their selection, and remain so throughout their term.

Section 2. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall become effective according to law.
