

ORDINANCE NO. 244

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 242, ARTICLE II 2.10.2 LAND CLEARING, PROVIDING CONTRACTORS AND LAND DEVELOPERS THE AUTHORITY TO BURY LAND CLEARING REFUSE, BRUSH, BRANCHES, OR TREES WITHIN THE SIDE AND REAR SET BACKS OF UNDEVELOPED PROPERTY AFTER OBTAINING THE PROPER PERMITS, REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of Mexico Beach has determined that it is in the best interests of the City that this ordinance be enacted, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF MEXICO BEACH, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Article II 2.10.2 LAND CLEARING, Page 51 of the City of Mexico Beach Land Development Regulations dated May 21, 1991, is amended as follows:

Contractors and land developers shall not burn brush, branches, or trees within the corporate limits of the city. All land clearing refuse may be either hauled from the premises and properly disposed of by the contractor or developer that has initiated the project or said refuse may be buried within the established rear and side set backs of the development site. These actions may only be accomplished after proper permitting has been obtained by either the developer or contractor.

Section 2. All ordinances, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3. Violation. Any person or persons violating this ordinance is guilty of a misdemeanor of the second degree, punishable as provided by State Statute.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
