

## ORDINANCE NO. 25

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING LIVESTOCK ON PUBLIC BEACHES; PROVIDING A DEFINITION OF LIVESTOCK; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TOWN OF MEXICO BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. For the purposes of this ordinance the term "head of livestock" shall mean any horse, cow, hog or other grazing animal.

SECTION 2. It shall be unlawful for any person to bring, ride or transport any head of livestock onto the public beaches of Mexico Beach, Florida.

SECTION 3. Any person violating any provision of this ordinance shall be fined not more than \$25.00 (twenty-five dollars) or imprisoned not more than ten (10) days, or both such fine and imprisonment.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.

INTRODUCED at a regular meeting of the Town Council on the 9th day of May, 1972, and ADOPTED by the Town Council on the 20th day of June, 1972.
