ORDINANCE NO. 255

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 242, ARTICLE V <u>SIGNS</u> 5.02.02 H. DELETING THE WORD "FLAGS", REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Mexico Beach has determined that it is in the best interests of the City that this ordinance be enacted, therefore

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF MEXICO BEACH, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Article V, Signs 5.02.02 H., Page 127, of the City of Mexico Beach Land Development Regulations dated May 21, 1991, is amended and reads as follows:

H. Signs, commonly referred to as wind signs, consisting of one or more banners, pennants, ribbons, spinners, streamers or captive balloons, or other objects or material fastened in such a manner as to move upon being subjected to pressure by wind. See Figure 5.02.02.A.

Section 2. All ordinances, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3. Violation. Any person or persons violating this ordinance is guilty of a misdemeanor of the second degree, punishable as provided by State Statutes.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
