

## ORDINANCE NO. 26

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE DISCHARGING OF FIREARMS WITHIN THE TOWN LIMITS OF MEXICO BEACH; PROVIDING EXCEPTIONS; PROVIDING PENALTIES; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TOWN OF MEXICO BEACH, FLORIDA:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to discharge any gun, airgun, beebie gun or other firearm projecting lead or any missiles; providing that this section shall not be construed to prohibit any officer of the law from discharging a firearm when lawfully defending person or property.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall not be construed to prohibit tests of shooting skill held as fund raising activities by and under the supervision of recognized non-profit organizations.

Section 3. Any person convicted of violating this Ordinance shall be fined not more than \$100.00 or imprisoned for not more than 30 days, or both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
