## ORDINANCE NO. 261

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 242, ARTICLE II LAND USE: TYPE, DENSITY, INTENSITY, CHANGING TABLE 2.02.04 TABLE OF DENSITY AND DWELLING UNIT TYPES FOR RESIDENTIAL USE, REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Mexico Beach has determined that it is in the best interests of the City that this ordinance be enacted, therefore;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF MEXICO BEACH, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Article II 2.02.04, Page 20 of the City of Mexico Beach Land Development Regulations dated May 21, 1991, is amended changing the allowable housing types listed under Line 5 of the chart (General Commercial). This line should read:

Section 2. All ordinances or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3. Violation. Any person or persons violating this ordinance is guilty of a misdemeanor of the second degree, punishable as provided by State Statutes.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
