ORDINANCE NO. 265

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 242 ARTICLE IV

NATURAL RESOURCES PROTECTION CHANGING 4.02.05 EXEMPTIONS
ADDING "F. EXEMPTING THE SPECIE PINE AS A PROTECTED
TREE", REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES
IN CONFLICT AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Mexico Beach has determined that it is in the best interests of the City that this ordinance be enacted, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF MEXICO BEACH, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Article IV 4.02.05, Page 90, of the City of Mexico Beach Land Development Regulations dated May 21, 1991, is amended by adding Section F. and reads as follows:

F. The softwood coniferous (cone-bearing) tree known as the specie pine is exempted from tree protection requirements within this article.

Section 2. All ordinances or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3. Violation. Any person or persons violating this ordinance is guilty of a misdemeanor of the second degree, punishable as provided by State Statutes.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
