

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 102, SECTION 3.
COLLECTION PRACTICE ADDING PARAGRAPH E. PROVISIONS
FOR A COLLECTION FEE FOR HOUSEHOLD APPLIANCES CON-
TAINING REFRIGERANT AND FLUOROCARBONS.

WHEREAS, the City of Mexico Beach, Florida has determined that it
is in the best interests of the City that this ordinance be enacted, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF MEXICO BEACH, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Section 3. Collection Practice of Ordinance No. 102
dated the 14th day of October, 1980 is hereby amended by adding Paragraph E.
and reads as follows:

(E.) Property owners requesting removal of household appliances
containing refrigerant and fluorocarbons are required prior to pick-up to pay
a refrigerant and fluorocarbons de-commissioning fee. This fee is established
by contract and may fluctuate annually. The fee paid by the property owner will
be that fee established by contract at the time of removal.

Property owners utilizing curb side service without City noti-
fication will be charged an additional two dollars and fifty cents (\$2.50)
billing fee in addition to the de-commissioning fee. De-commissioning fees
and billing fee will be placed on the owners monthly water & sanitation
billing. Failure to pay these accrued charges will constitute termination of
these services.

INTRODUCED at a regular meeting of the City Council on the
13th day of October, 1992 and ADOPTED by the City Council on the 10th day
of November, 1992.
