

ORDINANCE NO. 276

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A PLAN AMENDMENT (93-1) TO THE CITY OF MEXICO BEACH COMPREHENSIVE PLAN, PLAN VOLUME ADOPTED MAY 8, 1990; SETTING FORTH THE AUTHORITY FOR AND LEGAL STATUS OF THE PLAN AMENDMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

WHEREAS, the Florida State Legislature enacted the Local Government Comprehensive Planning Act of 1975, Chapter 163, Florida Statutes which authorizes local governments to adopt a comprehensive plan, and

WHEREAS, the City of Mexico Beach was found to be in compliance with all requirements set forth by the Department of Community Affairs has now found it necessary to amend its Plan and submit to the Department of Community Affairs said amendment, and

WHEREAS, all requirements of Chapter 163, Florida Statutes, with regard to the preparation of the Plan Amendment and subsequent action by the City Council have been met,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF MEXICO BEACH:

Section 1. The City of Mexico Beach Comprehensive Plan Amendment 93-1, consisting of fourteen (14) pages, including future land use map where change is indicated, is hereby adopted.

Section 2. The City of Mexico Beach Comprehensive Plan Amendment 93-1 shall have the same legal status of the Comprehensive Plan as set forth in Chapter 163.3194, Florida Statutes.

Section 3. Should any section or part herein be declared invalid for any reason it shall not affect the enforceability or validity of any other section of this ordinance.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
