AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 102 SECTION 5 DATED OCTOBER 14, 1980, ADDING THE REQUIREMENT TO REMOVE FROM PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY AND SCREEN FROM PUBLIC VIEW ALL REFUSE CONTAINERS, REPEALING ALL ORD-INANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of Mexico Beach has determined that it is in the best interests of the City that this ordinance be enacted, therefore

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF MEXICO BEACH, FLORIDA:

Section 1.

Section 5 of Ordinance No. 102 dated October 14, 1980 is amended by deleting the entire section and replacing as written with the following:

Section 5. Refuse containers required, Proper placement of containers.

It shall be the duty of every person in possession, charge or control of any place in or from which garbage is created, accumulated or produced, to insure at all times that the refuse is not on the Public Right of Way and that the refuse and containers are screened from Public View. The owner of any multiple dwelling shall furnish proper refuse containers. Refuse containers located at multiple dwellings, if furnished by the owners, shall be marked so as to indicate the apartment, unit or flat to which they belong. Garbage bags as commonly purchased are not considered an acceptable refuse container for purposes of this ordinance (See Section 2. E. Definitions).

INTRODUCED at a regular meeting of the City Council on the 12th day of October, A. D., 1993, and ADOPTED by the City Council on the 9th day of November, 1993.
