ORDINANCE NO. 304

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 242, ARTICLE III SUBDIVISION REGULATIONS GENERAL STANDARDS, CHANGING 3.01.03 BUILDING SET BACK REQUIREMENTS, LAND USE DISTRICT CHART; ADDING THE PROVISION THAT STORAGE BUILDINGS MAY BE PLACED WITHIN FIVE (5) FEET OF THE REAR PROPERTY LINE.

WHEREAS, the City of Mexico Beach has determined that it is in the best interests of the city that this ordinance be enacted, therefore;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF MEXICO BEACH, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Article III 3.01.03 Page 57, Building Set Back Requirements Land Use District Chart is amended as follows:

Add: ***Storage buildings may be placed within five (5) feet of the rear property lines.

- Section 2. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.
- Section 3. Violation. Any person or persons violating this ordinance is guilty of a misdemeanor of the second degree, punishable as provided by State Statutes.
