

ORDINANCE NO. 31

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 6, PROVIDING FOR THE HOURS OF SALE OF INTOXICATING BEVERAGES IN THE TOWN OF MEXICO BEACH, FLORIDA; PROVIDING THAT SAID ORDINANCE IS AN EMERGENCY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the people of the Town of Mexico Beach that this Ordinance be enacted and take effect immediately, now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the People of the Town of Mexico Beach:

Section 1. There is hereby added to Ordinance No. 6 of the Ordinances of the Town of Mexico Beach:

"Section 5." which shall read as follows:

"No intoxicating beverages may be sold, consumed or served or permitted to be served or sold in any place holding a license under the Division of Beverages between the hours of 2:00 A.M. and 5:00 A.M."

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption.

Introduced at a Special Meeting of the Town Council on the 15th day of August, 1972, and adopted by the Town Council at a Special Meeting on the 15th day of August, 1972.

ORDINANCE NO. 32

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING SWIMMING WITHIN CERTAIN AREAS OF THE MEXICO BEACH CANAL; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Mexico Beach, Florida, has determined that it is in the best interests of the health, welfare and safety of the people of the Town of Mexico Beach that this Ordinance be adopted,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TOWN OF MEXICO BEACH, FLORIDA:

- 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to swim in the boat channel of the Mexico Beach Canal in an area extending from the confines of the uppermost marina to the mean low water mark of the Gulf of Mexico, where said Canal empties into the Gulf of Mexico.
- 2. Violation of this Ordinance shall be punishable by a fine of Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) or imprisonment for ten (10) days, or both such fine and imprisonment.
- 3. This Ordinance shall take effect as providing by law.
