

## ORDINANCE NO. 33

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING CAMPING AND TENTING ON PUBLIC PROPERTY WITHIN THE TOWN LIMITS OF MEXICO BEACH, EXCEPT WITHIN DESIGNATED AREAS; PROVIDING FOR THE DESIGNATION OF CAMPING AND TENTING AREAS BY THE TOWN COUNCIL; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Mexico Beach, Florida, has determined that it is in the best interests of the health, welfare and safety of the people of the Town of Mexico Beach that this Ordinance be adopted,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TOWN OF MEXICO BEACH, FLORIDA:

1. It shall be unlawful for any person to erect any structure on any public property within the town limits of Mexico Beach, Florida, for the purpose and with the intention of using such structure as living quarters for any period of time. Provided, however, the Town Council may, in its discretion, designate certain public property within the town limits of Mexico Beach which shall be available for the erection of structures to be used as living quarters.
2. Any person violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall be fined Fifteen (\$15.00) dollars, or imprisoned for ten (10) days, or both such fine and imprisonment.
3. This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
