## ORDINANCE 386

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 379 CONCERNING MULTI-FAMILY DWELLINGS SERVICED BY ONE CONNECTION TO THE WATER UTILITY. THIS AMENDMENT PROVIDES FOR A BASE AMOUNT OF WATER PER UNIT RATHER THAN A BASE AMOUNT FOR THE CONNECTION TO THE WATER UTILITY. EACH UNIT WILL BE ALLOWED A BASE AMOUNT OF 4000 GALLONS PRIOR TO BEING CHARGED THE EXCESS RATE.

Whereas, the City of Mexico Beach has determined that it is in the best interest of the City that this ordinance be enacted; therefore, be it ordained by the City Council of Mexico Beach, Florida that the following changes be made to Ordinance 379:

# PART 1. USE OF THE MUNICIPAL WATER SYSTEM INSIDE THE CITY LIMITS

SECTION 7. CHARGE OR RATE FOR WATER SERVICE

SECTION 7. CHARGE OR RATE FOR WATER SERVICE.

C. Duplex dwellings or multi-family (MDS) on the same building site serviced by one service connection, prior to the passage of this ordinance, shall pay the minimum charge of \$ 16.25 for the first unit and \$16.25 per additional unit in the dwelling. All over 4,000 gallons **per unit** will be at the \$ 1.25 per thousand

#### SECTION 8. CHARGE OR RATE FOR SEWER SERVICE

D. Duplex dwellings or multi-family (MDS) on the same building site serviced by one service connection; prior to the passage of this ordinance shall pay the minimum of \$32.00 for the first unit and \$32.00 per additional unit in the dwelling. All usage over the first 4,000 gallons **per unit** will have a volumetric charge of \$2.15 per thousand.

# PART 2. USE OF THE MUNICIPAL WATER SYSTEM OUTSIDE THE CITY LIMITS

### SECTION 5. CHARGE OR RATE FOR WATER SERVICE.

C. Duplex dwelling or multi-family dwelling (MDS) on the same building site serviced by one service connection, prior to the passage of this ordinance, shall pay the minimum charge of \$21.65 for the first unit and \$21.65 per additional unit in the dwelling. All over 4,000 gallons per unit will be at \$1.87 per thousand.

SECTION 6. <u>EFFECTIVE DATE</u>. This ordinance shall become effective as provided by law.
