

ORDINANCE NO. 39

AN ORDINANCE ABOLISHING THE MUNICIPAL COURT OF THE TOWN OF MEXICO BEACH, FLORIDA; PROVIDING A TRANSITION PERIOD; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Mexico Beach, Florida, has determined that it is in the best interests of the health, welfare and safety of the people of the Town of Mexico Beach that this Ordinance be adopted,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TOWN OF MEXICO BEACH, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Pursuant to Section 168.031 of the Florida Statutes, the Municipal Court of the Town of Mexico Beach, Florida, is hereby abolished effective February 15, 1974.

Section 2. The Police Department of the Town of Mexico Beach, Florida, shall make all citations issued after February 1, 1974, returnable to the County Court of Bay County, Florida.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
