ORDINANCE 392

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 308 ESTABLISHING FEES FOR THE USE OF THE CITY MARINA AND A LATE FEE IN THE EVENT THAT A FEE IS NOT PAID WITHIN 10 DAYS FOLLOWING THE DUE DATE.

Whereas, the City of Mexico Beach has determined that it is in the best interest of the City that this ordinance be enacted; therefore, be it ordained by the City Council of Mexico Beach, Florida that the following changes be made to Ordinance 308:

SECTION 8. A provision is hereby established allowing for the collection of fees for mooring and the use of electrical power at the City-owned marina. These fees are payable to the City of Mexico Beach in the amounts specified in the table below. If the fees are paid on a monthly basis they are due in advance on the first working day of the month. If the fees are paid annually they are due in advance on the first working day in January. In the event that a monthly or annual fee is not paid within 10 days following the due date a \$15.00 late charge will be added to the fee. All fees for periods less than one month must be paid in advance upon arrival at the marina. All of the fees are to be placed in the Canal Reserve Account and dedicated to maintenance of the canal and associated facilities.
