ORDINANCE NO. 41

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING ALL STRUCTURES TO DISPLAY A HOUSE NUMBER.

WHEREAS, the Town Council is of the opinion that it is necessary for the preservation of the peace, safety, health and property of the Town and its inhabitants, and to provide for the usual daily operation of the Town and its departments that this Ordinance be enacted and take effect, now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TOWN OF MEXICO BEACH:

Section 1. DEFINITION. Any building or structure which is occupied by any person, or is used for the care and storage of any goods or merchandise or other property, shall bear a house number. Said house number must be of a size so as to be visible from the nearest street or access during daylight hours.

Section 2. ASSIGNMENT. House numbers and numbers for other structures will be assigned by the Town Clerk, and no other number may be displayed except that number assigned by the Town Clerk.

Section 3. NOTICE. The Town Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to publish a notice of this Ordinance as provided by law.

Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
