

ORDINANCE NO. 53

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE 1975 NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE AND PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Mexico Beach is of the opinion that an enactment of this Ordinance is required for the protection and preservation of peace, safety, health, and general welfare of the Town and its inhabitants, NOW, Therefore,

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TOWN OF MEXICO BEACH:

Section 1.

The 1975 National Electrical Code, as provided by the American Standards Association, and Handbook No. 81, as approved by the National Bureau of Standards of the United States Department of Commerce, and Pamphlet No. CB-1958 and Pamphlet No. PE-1958, as approved by the Florida Industrial Commission, and their amendments to date, be, and the same are hereby adopted.

Section 2.

Any ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 3.

Should any section of this ordinance be considered invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such declaration of invalidity shall have no effect upon the remaining provisions of this ordinance.

Section 4.

This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.

This Ordinance INTRODUCED at a regular meeting of the Town Council on the 25th day of February, A.D., 1975, and ADOPTED by the Town Council on the 25 day of March, A.D., 1975.
