

ORDINANCE NO. 547

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 242, ARTICLE V "SIGNS," SECTION 5.02.02 PROHIBITED SIGNS "SPECIFICALLY," ARTICLE "W," REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR SECTIONS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the people of the City of Mexico Beach that this ordinance be enacted, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF MEXICO BEACH, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Article V, "SIGNS," Section 5.02.02 Prohibited Signs "Specifically," Article "W" of the City of Mexico Beach Land Development Regulations dated May 21, 1991, is amended and shall from this point forward read as follows:


- W. No person or business shall operate or park any vehicle or trailer in a non-designated parking spot/lot on public right of way or public property so as to be visible from the public right of way, which has attached thereto or located thereon any sign or advertising device for the primary purpose of advertisement of products or directing people to a business or activity located on the same or nearby property or any other premises.

Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances thereof in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage.
