## **ORDINANCE NO. 556**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 502, SECTION 4(1) "RESIDENTIAL," SUBSECTION "B," REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR SECTIONS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the people of the City of Mexico Beach that this ordinance be enacted, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF MEXICO BEACH, FLORIDA:

- <u>Section 1</u>. Section 4(1), "Residential," Subsection "b," of Ordinance No. 507 dated November 8, 2005, is amended and shall from this point forward read as follows:
  - (b) Refuse containers and trash cans shall be designed, constructed, and used in such a manner as to preclude offensive odors from disturbing adjacent property owners or occupants. All trash cans or containers for residential collection of garbage, refuse, or trash shall be located at the side or rear of the residence and screened from public view.
- <u>Section 2.</u> All ordinances or parts of ordinances thereof in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

<u>Section 3.</u> This ordinance shall take effect upon passage.
