

ORDINANCE NO. 566

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 551, SECTION 1, SUBSECTION "B," AND SECTION 3, ADJUSTING THE CURRENT RATES TO BE CHARGED FOR IRRIGATION SYSTEMS INSIDE THE CITY LIMITS OF MEXICO BEACH, REPEALING ORDINANCES AND/OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT WITH THIS ORDINANCE AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the people of the City of Mexico Beach that this ordinance be enacted, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF MEXICO BEACH, FLORIDA:

Section 1, Subsection B, shall be amended to read as follows:

SECTION 1. CHARGE FOR RATE FOR WATER SERVICE

B. Residential Accounts:

| <u>Rates</u>     | <u>Monthly</u>  | <u>Basis</u>             |
|------------------|-----------------|--------------------------|
| ¾" 4,000 gallons | \$33.09, excess | \$2.56 per 1,000 gallons |
| 1" 6,000 gallons | \$50.02, excess | \$2.56 per 1,000 gallons |
| Hydrant Usage    | \$2.56 per      | 1,000 gallons            |

¾" – 4,000 gallons (irrigation meter) \$0.00 base rate; \$2.56 per 1,000 gallons usage

No sewer fees will be charged on irrigation meters

A utility tax will be charged on all water usage in accordance with local law.

Section 3 shall be amended to read as follows:


SECTION 3. SECONDARY WATER METERS FOR NON-SEWER CONNECTED ACTIVITIES

A. There will be no base charges for an irrigation meter. The secondary meter billing will not reflect a monthly minimum fee and but only water consumption (\$2.56 per thousand gallons usage), and all applicable taxes.


This ordinance shall become effective as provided by law.
