ORDINANCE 570

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 536, SECTION 2, DEFINING UTILITY TAX REVENUE REPEALING ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT WITH AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Mexico Beach has determined that it is in the best interest of the City that this ordinance be enacted, therefore, be it ordained by the City Council of Mexico Beach, Florida that:

Section 2.

Ordinance No. 536 will be amended to reflect the specific definition of utility tax revenue:

That the specific utility taxes to be accrued in the City of Mexico Beach Utility Tax fund shall be defined as:

- 1. Water Utility Tax
- 2. Electric Utility Tax
- 3. Natural Gas Utility Tax

All utility tax monies will be recorded in a Utility Tax Revenue ledger account, including any interest earned on said funds for the purpose(s) set forth in Section 1 of Ordinance above.

Section 3.

This Ordinance shall become effective upon passage.
