

ORDINANCE NO. 62

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE LEVY OF TAXES IN THE TOWN OF MEXICO BEACH, FLORIDA, FOR THE TAX YEAR 1976, LEVYING AN AD VALOREM TAX OF 3 MILLS ON ALL REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY WITHIN SAID TOWN, WHICH IS NOT EXEMPT UNDER LAW, FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING THE REQUIRED MATCHING FUNDS TO FEDERAL GRANT FUNDS MADE AVAILABLE AND WHICH MAY BE ALLOCATED IN THE FUTURE FOR THE PURPOSE OF INSTALLING A COMPLETE SEWAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEM AND ACQUISITION OF WATER SYSTEM FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1976-77; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.


WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Mexico Beach is of the opinion that it is necessary for the immediate protection and preservation of the peace, safety, health and property of the Town and its inhabitants, and to provide for the future installation of a sewage disposal system and acquisition of water system, that this ordinance be enacted and to be enacted, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TOWN OF MEXICO BEACH,
FLORIDA:

Section 1. There is hereby levied and assessed upon all real and personal property within the corporate limits of the Town of Mexico Beach, Florida, not exempt from taxation by the constitution and laws of the State of Florida an Ad Valorem tax for the year 1976 of 3 mills upon the dollar, of assessed valuation for the purpose of providing funds for preliminary engineering and future installation of a complete sewage system and acquisition of water system, for the fiscal year 1976-1977, said valuation to be based upon the assessment roll of Bay County, Florida.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption.

INTRODUCED at a Regular Meeting of the Town Council on the 23rd day of March, 1976, and ADOPTED by the Town Council on the 27 day of April, 1976.
