

ORDINANCE NO. 68

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 65; RELATING TO THE AD VALOREM TAXES IN THE TOWN OF MEXICO BEACH, FLORIDA; PROVIDING THAT THE TAX LEVIED IN SAID ORDINANCE SHALL INCLUDE PERSONAL PROPERTY AS WELL AS REAL PROPERTY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the people of the Town of Mexico Beach that this Ordinance be enacted and take effect immediately, now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TOWN OF MEXICO BEACH:

Section 1. Ordinances <sup>67, and 68</sup> No. 65 <sup>are</sup> hereby repealed.

Section 2. There is hereby levied and assessed upon all real property and personal property within the corporate limits of the Town of Mexico Beach, Florida, not exempt from taxation by the Constitution and Laws of the State of Florida an ad valorem tax for the fiscal year 1976-77, of <sup>9.6</sup> 6½ mills upon the dollar of assessed valuation for the purpose of providing funds for the ordinary and regular purposes of the Town of Mexico Beach, Florida, for the fiscal year 1976-77, said valuation to be based upon the assessment roll of of Bay County, Florida.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption.

INTRODUCED at a Special Meeting of the Town Council on the 29th day of July, 1976, and ADOPTED by the Town Council at a Special Meeting on the 29th day of July, 1976, as an emergency ordinance.
