## ORDINANCE NO. 70

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE LEVY OF TAXES IN THE TOWN OF MEXICO BEACH, FLORIDA, FOR THE TAX YEAR 1976, LEVYING AN AD VALOREM TAX of 9.5 MILLS, \$9.50 PER \$1,000 VALUATION, ON ALL REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY WITHIN SAID TOWN, WHICH IS NOT EXEMPT UNDER LAW FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING FUNDS FOR THE ORDINARY AND REGULAR REQUIREMENTS OF THE TOWN OF MEXICO BEACH FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1976-1977; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. ALL ORDI-NANCES IN CONFLICT WITH THIS ORDINANCE ARE HEREBY REPEALED.

WHEREAS, the Town Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the people of the Town of Mexico Beach that this ordinance be enacted and take effect immediately, now, therefore, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TOWN OF MEXICO BEACH:

Section 1. Ordinances No. 62, 65, and 68 are hereby

repealed.

<u>Section 2</u>. There is hereby levied and assessed upon all real property and personal property within the corporate limits of the Town of Mexico Beach, Florida, not exempt from taxation by the Constitution and Laws of the State of Florida an ad valorem tax for the fiscal year 1976-77, of 9.5 mills upon the dollar of assessed valuation for the purpose of providing funds for the ordinary and regular purposes of the Town of Mexico Beach, Florida, for the fiscal year 1976-77, said valuation to be based upon the assessment roll of Bay County, Florida.

<u>Section 3</u>. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption.

INTRODUCED at a Special Meeting of the Town Council on the 19th day of October, 1976, and ADOPTED by the Town Council at a Special Meeting on the 19th day of October, 1976, as an emergency ordinance.
