ORDINANCE NO. 72

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE LEVY OF TAXES IN THE TOWN OF MEXICO BEACH, FLORIDA, FOR THE TAX YEAR 1977, LEVYING AN AD VALOREM TAX OF 9.5 MILLS, \$9.50 PER \$1,000 VALUATION, ON ALL REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY WITHIN SAID TOWN, WHICH IS NOT EXEMPT UNDER LAW FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING FUNDS FOR THE ORDINARY AND REGULAR REQUIREMENTS OF THE TOWN OF MEXICO BEACH FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1977-1978, PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT WITH THIS ORDINANCE ARE HEREBY REPEALED.

WHEREAS, the Town Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the people of the Town of Mexico Beach that this ordinance be enacted, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TOWN OF MEXICO BEACH:

Section 1. There is hereby levied and assessed upon all real property and personal property within the corporate limits of the Town of Mexico Beach, Florida, not exempt from taxation by the Constitution and Laws of the State of Florida, an ad valorem tax for the fiscal year 1977-1978 of 9.5 mills upon the dollar of assessed valuation for the purpose of providing funds for the ordinary and regular purposes of the Town of Mexico Beach, Florida, for the fiscal year 1977-1978, said valuation to be based upon the assessment roll of Bay County, Florida.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption with retroactive date of October 1, 1977.

INTRODUCED at a Regular Meeting of the Town Council on the 21st day of June, 1977, and ADOPTED by the Town Council at a Special Meeting on October 5, 1977.
