

ORDINANCE NO. 75

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE ADOPTING MISDEMEANORS
UNDER THE LAWS OF FLORIDA AS MUNICIPAL
OFFENSES; PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION;
REPEALING ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith AND
PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TOWN OF MEXICO BEACH,
FLORIDA:

Section 1. All offenses under the laws of the State of
Florida which are classified as misdemeanors, are hereby adopted by
reference and made a municipal offense against the ordinances of the
Town of Mexico Beach, Florida.

Section 2. Persons, firms or corporations found guilty of
violating any of the several misdemeanors shall be punished as
provided by law.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in
conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its
passage and publication as provided by law.

as an Emergency Ordinance.
