AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE AFTROFRIATION OF FUNDS FOR FISCAL YEAR 1968-69 FOR THE TOWN OF MEXICO BEACH, FLORIDA, FOR THE FURPOSE OF PROVIDING THE FUNDS FOR THE ORDINARY AND REGULAR REQUIREMENTS OF THE TOWN OF MEXICO BEACH FOR FISCAL YEAR 1968-69; DECLARING THE ENACTMENT OF SAID ORDINANCE TO BE AN EMERGENCY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHIREAS, the Town Council is of the opinion that it is necessary for the immediate protection and preservation of the peace, safety, health, and property of the Town and its inhabitants that this Ordinance be eneacted and take effect immediately, now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TOWN OF MEXICO BEACH:

Section I. There is hereby appropriated the sum of \$10,625.00 for the General Fund for the fiscal year 1968-69 to be used in the operation of said departments for the Town of Mexico Beach, Florida as set forth in the Budget of said Town on file with the Town Clerk.

Section II. The Town Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to publish a notice of this Ordinance as provided by law.

Section III. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption.

INTRODUCED at a regular meeting of the Town Council on the 1st day of October, 1968, and ADOPTED by the Town Council on the 7th day of October, 1968.
