

RESOLUTION 2019-04

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MEXICO BEACH, FLORIDA REQUESTING THAT THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (“FDOT”) ALLOW THE CITY TO CONSTRUCT PERMANENT WALKWAYS WITHIN LAND AND RIGHT OF WAY OWNED BY FDOT.

WHEREAS, the City of Mexico Beach (the “City”) is constructing dune walkovers to replace the dune walkovers destroyed by Hurricane Michael; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Transportation is the owner of record for approximately one-third of a mile of beach within the City (Parcel ID No. 04186-010-000) and the adjoining US 98 right-of-way to the north is part of the State Highway System (collectively, “FDOT Property”); and

WHEREAS, to complete the dune walkover construction, the City will need access to the FDOT Property for staging and construction; and

WHEREAS, whereas portions of the permanent dune walkovers will be constructed in and remain in the FDOT Property; and

WHEREAS, the City has been coordinating with FDOT about this project and will require FDOT’s permission to work within the FDOT Property and construct permanent improvements within the FDOT Property.

BE IT RESOLVED that the City hereby requests permission from FDOT to access, stage within, perform construction activities within, and construct permanent dune walkover paths and structures within the FDOT Property on behalf of itself and its authorized contractors, engineers and consultants. It is further resolved that the Mayor is authorized to execute any license, easement, or routine agreements required by FDOT related to this request.

THIS RESOLUTION shall be effective immediately upon passage.


