

RESOLUTION 21 - 39

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MEXICO BEACH FLORIDA ADOPTING A TENTATIVE MILLAGE RATE FOR THE TAX YEAR 2021-2022 IN ACCORDANCE WITH 200.065, FLORIDA STATUTES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council has provided notice of a tentative budget hearing as required by law; and

WHEREAS, the City Council does hereby adopt its tentative millage rate of 7.0 mills that is equal to the rolled back rate of 7.178 mills; and

WHEREAS, the City Council shall consider and adopt a final millage rate at its final budget hearing on September 22, 2021 at 5:01 p.m. at Mexico Beach City Hall, which is located at 201 Paradise Path, Mexico Beach, FL.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mexico Beach City Council as follows:


1. The City has levied and assessed upon all real property and personal property within the corporate limits of the City of Mexico Beach, Florida, not exempt from taxation by the Constitution and Laws of the State of Florida, a tentative ad valorem tax for the fiscal year 2021-2022 of 7.0 mills upon the dollar of assessed valuation for the purpose of providing funds for the ordinary and regular purposes of the City of Mexico Beach, Florida, for the fiscal year 2021-2022, said valuation to be based upon the assessment roll of Bay County, Florida.
2. The tentative millage of 7.0 mills is equal to the rolled back rate of 7.178 mills.
3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

Done and adopted at the Public Hearing of the City Council on the 8th day of September 2021.


