RESOLUTION 21-46

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MEXICO BEACH, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE GRANT APPLICATIONS AND GRANT RELATED DOCUMENTS

AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATELY EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Mexico Beach (the "City") relies on various grants for its recovery

from Hurricane Michael and its normal capital improvements and operations; and

WHEREAS, generally these grants do not commit the City to direct expenditures until such

time that the purchase or construction occurs, which would be approved in advance by the City

Council; and

WHEREAS, some grants involve the City agreeing to indemnify the granting agency and

devote time toward planning the project; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City for the City Administrator to evaluate and

pursue grant opportunities on behalf of the City and to have authority to execute grant applications

and grant related documents as provide herein.

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Mexico Beach, Florida that the

City Administrator or other appropriate officers of the City are authorized to execute and deliver

on behalf of the City, and any successor City Administrator, to apply for any federal, state, local,

or private grant that he deems to be in the best interests of the City of Mexico Beach and the City

Council further authorizes the City Administrator to execute all grant applications and grant related

documents, except for any that would require an expenditure of funds by the City without additional

prior approval of such expenditure by the City Council.
