

RESOLUTION 23-08

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MEXICO BEACH, FLORIDA APPROVING A GRANT FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, FOR DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION OF THE 15TH STREET PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE AND MULTI USE PATH IN THE AMOUNT OF \$350,000.00. PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, THE CITY OF MEXICO BEACH, acting by and through its City Council, is interested in installing multi-use path and bridge for walking, recreation, etc., and

WHEREAS, funding for such shared use paths and bridge is available through the State of Florida Department of Transportation,

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MEXICO BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the City fully supports the idea of designing and construction of a multi-use path and bridge at the following locations in Mexico Beach, Florida: (1) along the north side of 15th Street from Joe Dr, connecting with the existing path located approximately at 123 15th Street.
2. That the City agrees to enter into a Local Agency Program Agreement with the State Florida Department of Transportation, Florida Department of Financial Services, for the purpose of accomplishing the design and construction of the multi-use path and bridge described in paragraph 1 above. The Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to sign the Agreement.
3. That the City Engineer, Dewberry, is authorized to proceed with the design of the project, once the State of Florida Department of Transportation executes the agreement.
