Proposals will be publicly opened at this time. Only submittals received by the stated time and date will be considered. Submittals received after the time set for the opening will be rejected and returned unopened to the submitter. All submittals shall be submitted in a sealed envelope and clearly labeled, "RFP 2025-04 Bid Mexico Beach Amphitheater at Parker Park Project." Please provide one (1) original, two (2) copies of the bid. Any Addendums issued during the advertisement period shall be posted to the above website no later than 5:00 PM (central time) March 7, 2025. Quotes shall be firm for ninety (90) days.
