DID YOU KNOW...

As tourist season ramps up, we’ll most likely start hearing rumbles about brown water flowing into the Gulf from the canal as well as 8th St. outfall. The water is brown due to tannins. Tannins are organic compounds that are derived from the decomposition of plant material, such as leaves, twigs, and roots. They are commonly found in the waters of rivers, streams, and wetlands, particularly in areas with high levels of vegetation...like the land around Mexico Beach.
