



To better serve you, the utility department will be smoke testing city sewer lines. The smoke testing will occur sometime during the following dates:

April 14th – July 18th

between the hours of 8am until 4pm.

Please visit our website at www.mexicobeachfl.gov for the weekly schedule. Please keep in mind this is a tentative schedule. If changes to the schedule are made we will update the website and Facebook.

On the inside of your house, smoke or its odor may come out of the plumbing or fixtures. The smoke being used is harmless to plants and animals and leaves no residuals or stains. If smoke gets into your house, please ventilate your house. The smoke is an indication that gases and odors from the sewer may be escaping into your house/building, which can be an unpleasant and dangerous health hazard.

Location, identification, and correction of the source of smoke entering your house/building is urgently advised. The correction of any defects in the pipes and sewer on private property is the responsibility of the owner. If you have any questions, please contact:
