Solid Waste Pickup & Disposal – Addendum No. 2

Date: February 6, 2026

Question 1: Will residential recycling be set up as a subscription service to be paid individually by the resident to the contractor or will all residential units receive recycling and billed through the city?

Response 1: Levels of service will be negotiated.

Question 2: Does the franchise agreement include the commercial business?

Response 2: Not at this time.

Question 3: What recycling processing facilities are available to take the recycling to?

Response 3: I do not know what is available in the area.

Question 4: What is the current bulk service collection schedule? Can proposer submit an on-call service and a weekly collection schedule?

Response 4: Currently we do not offer bulk service collection. Scheduling would be part of the contract negotiations.

Question 5: Is there currently back door service?

How many medical?

How many pay extra?

Response 5: Yes, back door service is provided to all residents as part of their monthly fee.

Question 6: Question 1: from Addendum No 1, refers to not asking for in-depth pricing or scheduling” Does that mean that pricing is not required for our proposal?

Response 6: Correct, this is a Request for Qualifications only.

Question 7: What criteria will be used to grade qualified proposers?

Response 7: Criteria could include qualifications and experience, technical capability and service approach, personnel, financial strength and risk profile, safety and regulatory compliance, customer service, sustainability and future readiness and tourist season population surge service plan.

Question 8: How many proposers will the city be choosing to interview further?

Response 8: Dependent upon response.

Question 9: Can the city provide the annual tons for household waste that was collected in FY 2025?

Response 9: 1,400 tons.

Question 10: On page 5 of the RFQ, there is reference to 1,400 tons of bulk waste. In addendum #1 under Response 17 it states, "We do not currently have bulk waste service" Can you identify what the 1,400 tons of bulk waste is which is referenced in RFQ?

Response 10: That should read solid waste.

Question 11: On page 11 of the RFQ under Section 3.0 "Basis of Prices and Method of Payment" paragraph 3.01 and 3.02 reference section 4.03, there is no section 4.03 in the RFQ, can this section be provided or clarified?

Response 11: Prices and method of payment will be determined during contract negotiations.

Question 12: Under section 3.01 and 3.02, it states" shall be computed based upon the actual number of Residential Units to which the Contractor provided such services during each month of this Contract". Question: will the contractor be paid based on the actual services performed each month or the total number of homes. Please clarify?

Response 12: Total number of homes.

Question 13: Can the City provide a sample bid sheet to be used?

Response 13: This is a Request for Qualifications only. A bid sheet is not necessary.

Question 14: Is the household service limited to cart contents only?

Response 14: If I understand the question, no. If there is a bag of trash next to a full cart we would expect the ba to be disposed of as well.

Question 15: Is there a required bid bond to be included with the proposal?

Response 15: No there is not.

Question 16: Are the proposals for each residential home to be bid as a consolidated unit price to include household waste, yard debris, bulk items and recyclables or each line item separated?

Response 16: This is a request for Qualifications only, proposals do not need to include pricing.
